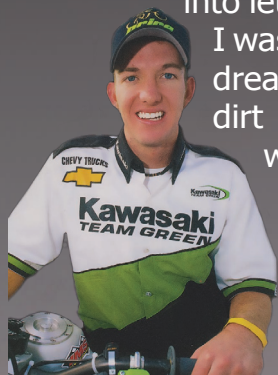


Spiritual & Life Experience
